

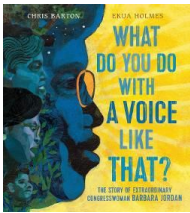
# Celebrate Black Heroes and History at a New Orleans Public Library!

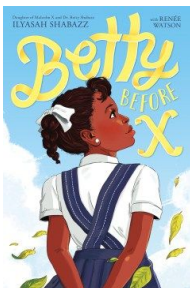
