Students & Academic

- 1. COVID cases are dropping. Optional, weekly surveillance testing remains in place at our three campuses.
- 2. Approximately 2/3 of our student body have complied with the vaccination mandate set forth by New Orleans Public Schools. We are reaching out to students whose families have not complied.
- 3. Student achievement is a priority for all network leaders and administrators. We are hoping to reinstate grouping for students in reading by proficiency level.
- 4. The Strong Schools Strategic Planning process is breaking down priorities that will guide our work during the next 3-5 years.

Faculty, Staff, and Administration

- 1. Our administrators, faculty, and staff have demonstrated an unbelievable level of professionalism and flexibility throughout these tough times.
- 2. A group of 16 teachers and facilitators recently attended the SFA conference in Orlando, FL.
- 3. A plan for summer professional learning is being organized and resources are being secured.
- 4. Faculty and Staff are currently in the "Intent to Return" phase of our talent cycle.
- 5. Dr. Douglas was admitted to the LA Superintendent's Academy. Mrs. Persick is entering year 2 of the E3 Fellowship. Mrs. Kramer is starting year 1 of the E3 fellowship. Mr. Mathes is completing the Edunomics class for school business executives.

Family and Community Involvement

1. Vaccination events have been scheduled to provide adults and children with access on site to COVID vaccines.

Operations and Facilities

1. We are following the LDH and CDC guidelines for positive cases.
