Students & Academic

- 1. The second quarter ends on Friday, December 16, 2022. Report cards for students in grades K-8 will be distributed in January 12, 2023.
- 2. Second quarter diagnostic assessments and quarterly exams are scheduled this week and next. We look forward to measuring our progress.
- 3. Fall Sports and Clubs provided fun opportunities at each campus. Moderators and coaches received their Fall stipends. Spring Sports and Clubs are planned for the second semester.

Faculty, Staff, and Administration

- 1. The two staff Impact Days were Wednesday, September 21, 2022 and Wednesday, November 9, 2022. During these impact days, teachers and school leaders are using multiple forms of data to identify strengths and opportunities to develop a path forward for next steps.
