Hynes Charter Schools follow NOLAPS' COVID Guidance and Re-opening Guidelines:

2022-2023 Current CDC COVID-19 Guidance Including Major Changes as of <u>August 12, 2022</u>:

- Quarantine: The CDC no longer recommends a 5-day quarantine period for unvaccinated persons who were exposed to the virus.
 - Those that are exposed are to wear a well-fitting face mask for 10 days after their exposure.
 - Those that are exposed are to receive testing within 5 days of their exposure.
 - Please see here for more information.
- Test to Stay: Test to stay is no longer required to ensure exposed and unvaccinated persons can remain on campus.
 - However, getting tested is still recommended for all exposed persons within 5 days of their exposure. NOLA-PS highly recommends that schools use resources provided by the district to test exposed individuals (weekly testing and/or provided antigen tests).
