Hynes Charter School Corporation CEO Report December 9, 2024

Celebration!

Congratulations to our students, teachers, and leaders at our three schools for increases in both school performance scores and impressive performance in growth scores.

Students & Academic

- 1. The first semester is closing on December 19th. We are currently assessing students using our middle-of-the-year benchmarks to measure performance and student growth since August.
- 2. Our winter holiday starts December 20th. Teachers and staff return on January 6th and classes resume on January 7th.

Faculty, Staff, and Administration

- 1. School leaders are using the Louisiana Educator's Rubric and evaluation system to observe and provide feedback to teachers. Coaching plans are developed based upon observations.
- 2. The Hynes Holiday party is scheduled for Friday, December 13, 2024, at the Cannery.
- 3. We have started a Science of Reading cohort to ensure that our K-3rd teachers receive the necessary 50 hours of professional learning set up by the Louisiana Legislature. Each teacher will take the course asynchronously (and it will be paced by one of our leaders) on the state's Canopy site and Hynes will pay a stipend for this experience. We have 23 teachers and two leaders enrolled in the course.
- 4. Approximately 50 teachers of Mathematics in grades 4th-8th are enrolled in the state's numeracy training in Canopy.

Family and Community Involvement

- 1. Our leaders hosted three different school tours for prospective students.
- 2. Hynes-UNO PTO is planning a fundraising soiree on Saturday, March 29th.
- 3. Hynes received notice that three of our grant applications have been funded:
 - a. New Orleans Recreation and Culture Fund
 - b. Pro Bono Publico Foundation Grant
 - c. System-wide Needs Fund

Operations and Facilities

- 1. Hynes-UNO will host their annual NOLAPS visit on January 30, 2025.
- 2. Our organization is completing the user agreements and processes to be an authorized non-criminal justice agency (NCJA) that sends fingerprints and receives criminal history record information (CHRI) for non-criminal justice purposes because of the responsibilities we have as school operators with authority over the supervision of children.

Edward Hynes Charter Schools Facilities Report December 9, 2024

UNO:

- Lemoine is on track to have all remaining punch lists and change order work to be completed by the end of the winter break.
- Currently, Lemoine and the engineers are still working on some issues
 discovered when the units requested heating when the weather changed.
 Functional commissioning of the heating system is still ongoing. Once that is
 completed, we will know if anything else needs to be corrected.
- The HVAC Maintenance contract has been received from Gotee

Lakeview:

- The next phase of the NOLA PS building envelope repairs project will be presented to the board during its December meeting for intent to award.
- NOLA PS's yearly facilities inspection went well. A few items need corrections, which have been taken care of. The post-inspection will take place in two weeks.

Parkview:

- NOLA PS conducted a pre-bid for the fencing upgrades project on Friday, December 6th.
- Hynes PV PTO is preparing to upgrade the A/V in the gym/café. They will fund this entire project. I am assisting them in procuring this scope of work.

WHEREAS, the allocation provides stipends in the amount of \$2,000 for certificated staff and \$1,000 for support staff, to be paid by December 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, certificated and support staff of Hynes Charter Schools are eligible for this allocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Board of Directors retroactively approves the dissemination of \$2,000 on October 10, 2024, to each staff in a teaching position or possessing a teaching certificate and \$1,000 on October 10, 2024, to each employee in a supporting role without a teaching certificate.
