end of the school year. Since joining Hynes in December 2018, Mathes has played a critical role in the charter network's growth, overseeing financial strategy during a period of major expansion and navigating the COVID-19 pandemic.

Orleans, as well as an undergraduate degree in Computer Information Systems from Loyola University New Orleans. A Certified Public Accountant, he brought extensive financial leadership experience to Hynes, having served as Vice President for Finance & Administration at Loyola University New Orleans. His career also includes roles as Director of Internal Auditing at Loyola (1982-2000), Chief Administrative Officer for the Archdiocese of New Orleans (2000-2007), and Vice President for Finance & Administration at Our Lady of the Lake College in Baton Rouge.

Under Mathes' financial stewardship, the network successfully expanded to include three campuses: Hynes-Lakeview (PK3-8), Hynes-UNO (K-6, growing to K-8), and Hynes-Parkview (K-8).
