Students & Academic

- 1. We are in the final days of LEAP testing for this year.
- 2. Quarterly exams are scheduled beginning May 7th.
- 3. End of year assessments are scheduled at the end of this week.
- 4. The final day for PreK, Kindergarten, and 8th grade is Friday, May 16th.
- 5. The final day for students in grades 1-7 is Tuesday, May 20th.
- 6. 8th grade graduations are scheduled in the morning on May 23rd.
- 7. The final day for PreK, K, and 8th grade students is Friday, May 16th.
- 8. Hynes-LV 8th grade Disney trip is May 12th-15th.
- 9. Hynes-PV has some end of year things planned for their 8th grade.

Faculty, Staff, and Administration
